In 1999 Bob and Joyce Newton open the gates to Newton Park which is located in Lakeland, Indiana. The vision of the Newtons was to provide a quality facility and "A place for kids". Newton Park features three (3) quality fields that are second to none in the Midwest. One of the focal points of the park is the 2 story press box which provides a 360 degree view of the facility and atop the press box is a Golden Dome which is a replica of the Golden Dome at the nearby University of Notre Dame.

Newton Park hosted its first BPA event in 2005 and has been on the schedule every year, with numerous qualifiers and has hosted a BPA State Championship every year. In addition to BPA, Newton Park has been host to many NSA Fast Pitch events. The annual schedule for the facility will feature 20 plus BPA/NSA and has been that way for many years.

On November 3, 2019, Newton Park was inducted into the BPA Sports Hall of Fame in the Meritorious Category.
